

"Latin America and the Caribbean"





Here's what we will work together to explore, understand, and be able to do in this unit:

- Locate, label, and identify, on a regional map, the main physical, political, and man-made features of Latin America and the Caribbean.
 (See cartography application activity = 'regional mapping' = for specific requirements)
- 2. Assess the region's principal natural resources and discuss their significance.
- 3. Compare and contrast the major early civilizations of Latin America.
- 4. Analyze the impact of European colonization on the region's historical and cultural development.
- 5. Evaluate the influence of the Roman Catholic Church on the region's culture.
- Redefine "standard of living;" concentrating on factors used in the determination of the standard of living, as well as how it applies to this region.
- 7. Define a single crop economy and explain how it has affected some of the countries in the region, through the use of appropriate examples.
- 8. Compare and contrast the role of agriculture with the role of industrial development throughout this region.
- 9. Explain how transportation in the region has been influenced by geographic conditions.
- 10. Discuss the background of the Panama Canal, its importance within the region, and how it impacts the rest of the world.
- 11. Compare and contrast the advantages/disadvantages of tropical rain forest development.
- 12. Identify and explain the "critical issues" challenging the region of Latin America and the Caribbean.
