# SUBJECT: C.2.h. APPROVE PROCESS FOR RECRUITMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF OAK PARK CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE MEMBERS

ACTION

ISSUE:	Shall the Board of Education discuss and approve a process for appointment of members to the Oak Park Citizen's Oversight Committee (OPCOC)?			
<b>BACKGROUND:</b>	<ul> <li>Having served two consecutive two-year terms as permitted by law, three members of the 12-member OPCOC will term out on January 15, 2015. The Board has two options in addressing these vacancies: <ol> <li>The Board could leave the seats vacant for the remainder of the 2014-15 term, leaving 9 members to oversee Measures C, C6, and R. California law requires a minimum of 7 members.</li> <li>The OPCOC respectively requests that the Board appoint new members to assist with its oversight work during the 2014-15 term.</li> </ol> </li> <li>If it determines to fill the three vacancies, the Board is asked to discuss the process it wishes to use to select the replacement members for the next two-year term. Historically, the Board has elected to create an application for membership, appoint a Board sub-committee to paper-screen candidates, with the entire Board interviewing and selecting the new members. Assuming a continuation of this practice, the precise timing will be discussed at the Board's meeting, with a goal of appointing the new members not later than the Board's meeting on December 9, 2014. Alternatively, after discussion, the Board may select a different recruitment and selection process.</li> </ul>			
ALTERNATIVES:	<ol> <li>Approve the continuation of the historical recruitment and selection process, with a goal of appointing three new OPCOC members not later than the December 9, 2014 Board meeting.</li> <li>After discussion, identify and implement an alternate recruitment and selection process, with a goal of appointing the new OPCOC members not later than the December 9, 2014 Board meeting.</li> <li>Do not appoint three new OPCOC members to complete the 2014-15 term.</li> </ol>
