BACKGROUND: ALTERNATIVES:		portable site to compare the pure the pure the compare to compare the pure the compare the pure the pu	At its meeting on May 20, 2014, the Board approved a proposal to relocate 5 portable classrooms from Oak Park High School to the Oak View High School site to create an OPIS campus. The project, now designated OPUSD Project 14-28F, calls for installation of a relocatable restroom facility. The District has received the attached proposals from Silver Creek Industries, Inc. for the purchase and installation of a restroom facility, for a total of \$51,546.00. The first proposal is for the modular building, in the amount of \$44,767.07, which falls below PCC threshold of \$84,100 for bidding of equipment. The second proposal, in the amount of \$6,778.93, is for the delivery and installation of the structure, and utilizes the cooperative purchase provision of Los Alamitos Unified School District Bid #2010-0001. The Los Alamitos bid contains a provision commonly referred to as a "piggyback" clause, authorized by PCC 20118, which allows districts to utilize the bids of other public agencies, saving time, effort and money. In order to receive the most favorable pricing, and to conform to the bidding requirements of PCC 20111-20118, it is recommended that the Board authorize the purchase of the new relocatable restroom facility from Silver Creek, per the attached proposals, in the total amount of \$51,546.00. 1.
